

Ferdinand Park & Recreation Board Minutes

June 6, 2018

Regular meeting of Ferdinand Park & Recreation Board was held in the town office on Wednesday, June 6 beginning at 4:35 p.m. Attending were Mike Steffe, Matt Weyer, Dolores Boeglin and Tom Lueken.

Minutes were approved with motion by Mike and second by Matt. Expense report was approved with motion from Mike and second by Dolores.

Tom reported that he had quote from Tom's Lawn on a new Grasshopper mower for 13,675.00, power fold deck 3,460.00 and roll bar 140.00. Trade in of old mower would be 2500.00 and government discount is 2,591.25 bringing total to 112,183.75. The board agreed we didn't really have choice on purchasing a mower and felt this was good deal. Dolores made motion to have Tom proceed with purchase. Mike seconded motion.

Tom also said he had a quote from Tenbarge for removing sod on girls field at 5th St. and regrading the field for 10,175.00. This was tabled to be addressed in the future.

Replacing the fall area at the playground at 5th St. has begun. Hopefully to be completed by mid-July.


A discussion was held on plans and schedules for the Old Town Lake project. Matt did extensive work on setting up schedules for all paperwork to be completed and bids to be let.

Musical instrument installation is complete at 18th St. and signs for disk golf should all be completed after the Heimatfest. Sand has been added to the volleyball court and Mike has sprayed lines. The Y is planning to begin open play volleyball on Mondays

Dolores made a motion to start first year summer help at 8.50 per hour with a second by Mike.

July meeting has been set for July 11th due to the 4th of July holiday being on first Wednesday.
