

ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 10

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FERDINAND MUNICIPAL
CODE REGARDING GENERAL PROHIBITIONS ON USE OF
TOWN'S DECORATIVE LIGHTING POLES FOR
ADVERTISEMENT PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the Town of Ferdinand has chosen to replace some of its regular electric light poles with decorative lighting along State Road 162 (Main St.) and expects to continue replacing some of the regular electric poles with decorative lighting each year; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has considered the current number of decorative poles and the impracticality and difficulty for anyone other than Town personnel using Town equipment to affix any advertisement, flags or banners to the Town's decorative lighting; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

1. Ferdinand Municipal Code Chapter 1.100 General Prohibitions concerning Town decorative lighting is added as follows:


1.100.010. General Prohibitions.

A. The Town's decorative lighting is not available to advertise for profit or non-profit businesses or festivals or events which are not Town sponsored events.

B. The Town reserves the right to affix U.S. Flags and such advertisements of Town sponsored events as it deems appropriate on the decorative lighting poles.
